

The Ansar were a righteous group of people in Medina who invited and welcomed the Messenger of Allah, Prophet Muhammad (saw), without question, when he and the Muhajireen migrated from Makkah to Medina.

Their support was legendary; not only did they provide, our Beloved Prophet (saw) and the Sahabah (ra) with accommodation in their own homes, they gave food, provisions and anything they could to help.

The Ansar were the helpers, and shared whatever they had with Prophet Muhammad (saw) and the Muhajireen. They set an example of genuine care. With compassion and kindness they showed real support.
